### **GENERAL POLICY**

Fugro Ground Geophysics believes that the prevention of any work related illness or injury to its people and contractors is critical to the Company's success as a major provider of geophysical services.

We are committed to providing a safe, healthy working environment for all personnel and contractors operating at our offices and work sites by maintaining a robust Occupational Safety and Health (OSH) management system compliant with all legal requirements. In doing so our policies, procedures and standards will reflect the intent as well as the substance of Occupational Safety and Health, and all other Acts under which the Company operates.

### **OBJECTIVES**

In implementing this OSH Policy, we are committed to achieve the following:

- Recognition as a leader in OSH management in the Geophysical Services industry;
- Elimination of workplace injuries and illness through specific and measurable objectives and targets which drive continuous improvement in OSH;
- Provide support at all levels of the business to promote compliance with safety requirements; and
- Actively support and participate in activities with industry stakeholders to improve safety standards within the Geophysical Services industry.

We will build success in achieving our objectives through Company-wide strategies:

- Working with customers and contractors to ensure that the Company's OSH Policy, Standards and Procedures are maintained;
